

SLAB POLICY ON TRANSITION TO ISO/IEC 17025: 2017

SLAB accredited and applicant testing and calibration laboratories are required to comply with the requirements of this policy commencing 25th of December 2017. The new ISO/IEC 17025:2017 (General Requirements for the competence of testing and calibration laboratories) standard was published on the 30th November 2017 and will replace ISO/IEC 17025:2005. The agreed transition period is 3 years from the date of publication. This means that all SLAB accredited testing and calibration laboratories will need to have successfully transferred to the new standard within 3 years from the publication date (2017-11-30).

It is important that laboratories **purchase a copy of the new edition**, and understand the changes that have been made, at the earliest opportunity.

As per the SLAB policy on transition, accreditation granted as per ISO/IEC 17025: 2005 would not be valid after 30th November 2020.

In addition, the following are also applicable for this transition.

- 1. SLAB is ready to accept applications as per new standard ISO/IEC 17025:2017 after 28th of February 2018.
- 2. SLAB is ready to carry out assessments against ISO/IEC 17025:2017 after 30th March 2018.
- 2. SLAB does not accept new applications against ISO/IEC 17025:2005 after 25th August 2018.
- 3. All assessments of new applicants (pre-assessments/initial assessments) and SLAB accredited testing and calibration laboratories (surveillance assessments/re-assessments) will be conducted in accordance with ISO/IEC 17025:2017 from 1st January 2019 onwards as per their assessment schedules. Laboratories have option to request assessment as per ISO/IEC 17025:2017 before 1st of January 2019.
- 4. Testing and Calibration laboratories whose applications were accepted as per ISO/IEC 17025: 2005 and pending as on 25th August 2018 will be granted accreditation as per ISO/IEC 17025:2005 up to 31st December 2018.
 - Any Application pending on 25th August 2018 shall have to demonstrate compliance to ISO/IEC 17025:2017 to be accredited after 1st January 2019.
 - Accreditation will not be granted as per ISO/IEC 17025:2005 after 1st January 2019.
- 5. Testing and calibration laboratories granted accreditation as per ISO/IEC 17025:2005 before 1st of January 2019 shall undergo surveillance assessment to demonstrate their compliance to ISO/IEC 17025:2017 as per their normal assessment schedules and complete the process of surveillance assessment on or before 30th November 2020.
 - SLAB accredited Testing and Calibration Laboratories shall demonstrate full implementation of ISO/IEC 17025: 2017 by 30th November 2020.

The accreditation of any Testing and Calibration Laboratory which fails to demonstrate compliance to ISO/IEC 17025:2017 by 30th June 2020 shall be placed under temporally suspension for a maximum of 03 months. Failure to comply with ISO/IEC 17025: 2017 by 30th November 2020 would result in withdrawal of accreditation.
