ASSESSOR TRAINING COURSE ON ISO/IEC 17043: 2010

The Sri Lanka Accreditation Board for Conformity Assessment (SLAB) as National Accreditation Authority in Sri Lanka introduced new accreditation scheme for Proficiency Testing Providers and one proficiency testing provider has been accredited as per ISO/IEC 17043 and two more applicants in the process of accreditation. Assessments of above applicants and accredited organizations were conducted in association with external expertise and SLAB assessors who are currently working with the SLAB. SLAB is planning to extend its international recognition for proficiency testing provider accreditation with the completion of one accreditation cycle of accredited proficiency testing provider.

For the accreditation scheme of Proficiency Testing Providers, SLAB expects to conduct an assessor training programme from 19<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2022 in order to train a batch of assessors in compliance with the International Standard ISO/IEC 17043:2010. This programme will be conducted as physical training programme in accordance with health regulations and venue of the Programme will be notified to selected participants. This programme will be conducted in association with the National Accreditation Board for Laboratories, India with the financial support of United Nation Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) under the project titled, Mainstreaming Standards-Based Best Practices for Agri-Food Sector Development. Porgramme schedule and selection criteria are enclosed herewith.

The potential applicants need to successfully complete Assessors Training Course on ISO/IEC 17025: 2017/ISO 15189:2012 or ISO/IEC 17020:2012. Applicants with training on ISO/IEC 17043 and experience in organization of inter- laboratory comparisons/ Proficiency testing programmes or similar activities and potential proficiency testing providers are encouraged to follow this programme in order to become a qualified assessor or accredited PT provider. Selection of participants will be done by an independent committee considering above mentioned criteria current needs of the SLAB accreditation scheme for PT providers.

A nominal training fee of LKR 10 000/= will be charged per participant. Number of participants of this programe will strictly be limited to 20.

# ASSESSOR TRAINING FOR ACCREDITATION OF PROFICIENCY TESTING PROVIDERS CONDUCTED BY NATIONAL ACCREDITATION BOARD FOR TESTING/CALIBRATION LABORATORIES AND ORGANIZED BY SRI LANKA ACCREDITATION BOARD

#### Criteria for Assessor Training and Selection

#### 1. Eligibility

Applicants for assessor training should possess the following qualifications, experience and personal attributes.

#### 1.1 Pre-qualifications

(a) B Sc degree in a field relevant to laboratory testing/ medical testing/ calibration
(Eg. Chemistry, Physics, Engineering, Biology, Microbiology, Metrology, Biochemistry, Veterinary Science, Electrical & Electronics, Information Technology, Textiles, Materials Science/Engineering, Radiology, Forensic science, Molecular Biology & Gene Technology, medical/clinical testing etc.)

(b) At least four years of experience in a laboratory testing/inspection and two years of which in the quality management

(c) Employed as analyst, technician, consultant, clinical scientist or in a similar capacity related to Laboratory testing/calibration/inspection

## 1.2 Post training requirements

- a) On successful completion of the training programme for 5 days, each participant should undergo 05 mandays in at least 2 on-site assessments as an Observer under the guidance of a Team Leader/Technical Assessor to satisfy the criteria for an assessor/Technical assessor, if he/she is interested in working with SLAB. Applicants should be able to allocate adequate time (not continuously) for these assessments for training.
- b) Assessors who successfully complete the training should be able to commit to conduct assessments as assigned for a particular year.

Note: Provisions exist for payment of Assessor Fees

c) Each assessor working with SLAB should be prepared to develop his/her own skills in technology and conformity assessments through education and training and/or assessor knowledge sharing meetings.

### 2. Personal Attributes

Assessors should preferably have the following personal attributes.

- a) Knowledgeable of the functioning of a testing laboratory
- b) Knowledgeable of the standards related to testing and accreditation
- c) Have an open-minded, ethical and diplomatic approach in conducting assessments
- d) Should Have good communication skills and inter-personal skills
- e) Should be able to work as a part of a team
- f) Should be self-reliant and able to take impartial decisions.
- g) Should have knowledge in Computer including e-mail & internet

#### 3. Method of Selection and Appointment

- 3.1 Each application should be endorsed by the Chief Executive or the Head of Department of the working Institution for the suitability and availability of the applicant for accreditation work, if not applied individually.
- 3.2 Preference will be given to those who have served in accredited laboratories with sound quality management systems and those who have experience in quality management, quality assurance and quality system assessments, conducting and organizing interlaboratory comparisons/proficiency testing programmes and current needs of accreditation scheme for proficiency testing providers.
- 3.3 The number of places available in the programme is approximately 20.
- 3.4 The SLAB with the assistance of independent selection committee will assess the applications for selection.
- 3.5 Applications submitted after the closing date will not be considered for selection.
- 3.6 Applicants will be informed in writing of the selection.
- 3.7 Successful participants will be issued a Certificate by the SLAB, which is recognized internationally.
- 3.8 On completion of the required man-days of on-site training, each Assessor will be issued with a Letter of Appointment by the SLAB.
