ESSAY COMPETITION

Rules for applicants:

- The competition will be held for two categories:
 - Category 01: School children above grade 10
 - Category 02: Open
- Medium: Sinhala, Tamil & English
- One participant will be permitted to submit only one essay in one language. The essay must be written in clear handwriting or typewritten. Essays written in illegible handwriting would be rejected.
- The essay should contain not less than 750 words and not more than 1000 words.
- The essay shall be an original piece of work by the participant and has not entitled to the winning categories of any other competition.

AWARDS

- Winners for each category will be selected and awarded as follows: 01st Place – Rs. 20,000.00 with a certificate 02nd Place – Rs. 15,000.00 with a certificate 03rd Place – Rs. 10,000.00 with a certificate
 Merit prices – Gift with a certificate
- Winners of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd places of each category will be awarded certificates and cash prizes at the World Accreditation Day Celebration of Sri Lanka Accreditation Board. Invitations for the event will be sent to the winners. A student category winner may accompany one adult (parent/teacher) in participation for the event.
- The prize-winning essays and the photographs of the authors will be displayed at the SLAB e-Newsletter and SLAB Website
- The decision of the SLAB Judge panel regarding winners would be final.

For student category: The principal / Head of the school must certify that the applicant is a student of his / her school and that the essay was written by the student. For open category: Head of an Institute / Justice of Peace must certify that the essay was written by the participant. Application forms and essays should reach the above address before 31st May 2025. *Children of officials and members of the Sri Lanka Accreditation Board and other committees of SLAB would not be eligible to participate.
